LENT

In this season, we should practice the traditional forms of penance: fasting, abstinence from meat and luxuries, almsgiving, and prayer. In almsgiving we set aside for the needs of the Church and the poor, the savings we realize by our fast and abstinence. In prayer we keep all this observance directed towards God.

ASH WEDNESDAY

Wednesday of this week is Ash Wednesday, a day of fast and abstinence. The imposition of ashes will be available outside the church for school parents in the morning from 8:30 until 9:00, and for all other parishioners from 10:00 to 10:30 a.m., and in the evening from 6:30 until 7:00. Please wear a mask that covers both nose and mouth, and be mindful of social distancing as you approach the church to receive your ashes.

PENITENTIAL DISCIPLINE OF THE CHURCH

These precepts apply: “Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.” “Fridays are days of abstinence, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day.” The obligation stemming from these disciplines is a very serious one. The obligation to do penance comes from the Divine Law itself. However, special penitential days (Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays) are set aside so that Christians can join in a common observance of penance. The Law of abstinence is binding on everyone over the age of fourteen. Thus, on all Fridays we must abstain from meat, or substitute this with a significant act of piety or charity. The Law of fasting (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday) is binding on everyone over eighteen and under sixty. On these two days, in addition to abstaining from meat, we must eat only one full meal, two light meals, and no snacks.
