After the successful distribution of Holy Communion on Easter Sunday, we have decided to continue the practice each Sunday following the livestreamed Mass, until we will be able again to assist at the Mass in person.

Therefore, beginning this Sunday, April 11th, Holy Communion will be distributed outside the door of the church from the end of Mass **until 12:00**. You are asked to park your car in the parking lot, and to come down the steps to receive Communion, returning by walking around the rockery, so as to allow the necessary social distancing for others coming down the steps. You are reminded of the **absolute necessity to wear the mask, and to receive Communion in the hand**. Also, you are asked to return to your vehicle directly. Following Provincial Health directives, there is to be **no socializing**.

Although Holy Communion has always been available to those who requested it, we trust that this new availability will encourage all of you to come and take part.
