## HOLY COMMUNION

Holy Communion will be distributed outside the door of the church this Sunday from the end of Mass **until 12:00**. You are asked to park your car in the parking lot and to come down the steps to receive Communion, returning by walking around the rockery to allow the necessary social distancing for others coming down the steps. You are reminded of the **absolute necessity to wear a mask, and to receive Communion in the hand**. Next weekend we will be open for Mass with limited numbers so the distribution of Holy Communion outside the church will be discontinued.

## RESUMPTION OF MASS WITH A CONGREGATION

Beginning tomorrow, May 31<sup>st</sup>, **up to 50 people** may be present at the celebration of Mass. Weekday mornings (except Fridays) and Saturdays will be at 8:00 a.m. with a maximum of 50 people; a sign-in sheet will be posted in the vestibule. Friday morning Mass at 9:00 will be reserved for the school children, and available by live-stream for all others. For Sunday Mass, pre-registration will be required beginning at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesdays until 3:00 p.m. on Thursdays. Please call the parish office with names and contact information of those who wish to attend either the 7:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday, or the 8:30 a.m., 12 noon, or 5:00 p.m. Mass on Sunday. The 10:00 Sunday Mass will continue to be live-streamed only until churches are permitted to be open at full capacity.
