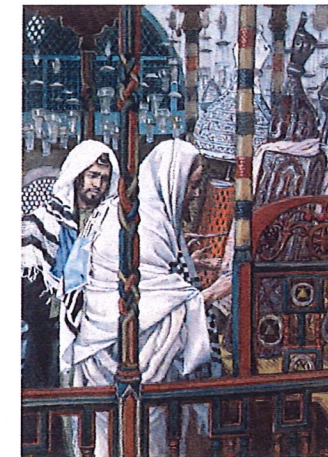

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICER MASK GUIDANCE

Masks are recommended in public indoor settings for all people 12 and older who are not yet fully vaccinated. You are fully vaccinated 14 days after dose 2.

My dear parishioners:

It is a joyful day for all of us as we are now able to return to church without restrictions: no more registering, no more signing in, no more distancing, no more sanitizing; we are now able to sing, to have holy water, to use the confessionals, to have altar servers. We thank God that the threat of the virus has been reduced, we thank Him for the effective vaccines, we thank Him that people have so faithfully complied with the rules for our common safety.

We still need to exercise prudence and caution. Masks are no longer mandatory but recommended out of consideration for those around us. We will hold off on the Offertory procession for the present. The sign of peace is restored but we respect those who may be uneasy with the handshake; a simple mutual bow can be a very proper adaptation.

The 10:00 Mass will continue to be live-streamed for a few more Sundays and will not be open to the general public, but once the Archbishop lifts the dispensation from the Sunday obligation we will stop the live-streaming and reopen that Mass. Keep in mind that if you are ill or feeling vulnerable you should not attend, and no dispensation is necessary.

You are to be commended for your wonderful cooperation, your prayers, and your support over the past fifteen months.

The whole parish owes a great debt of gratitude to the volunteers who have given so generously of their time and talent to ensure the daily live-streaming of the Mass.
